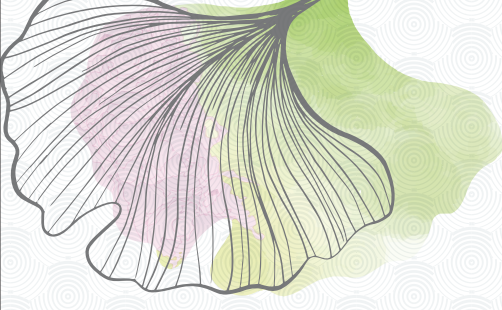

Unite: Encourages everyone (healthcare workers, patients, and communities) to work together.

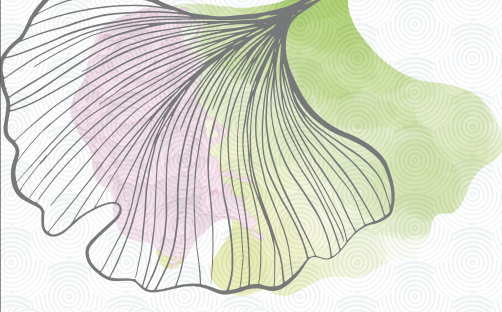
Protect: Emphasizes protecting vulnerable groups like children, the elderly, and the immunocompromised.

Activities: The week involves a variety of activities designed to reinforce good practices



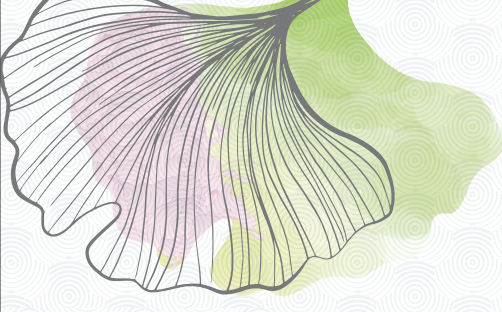
IMPORTANCE OF INTERNATIONAL INFECTION PREVENTION WEEK

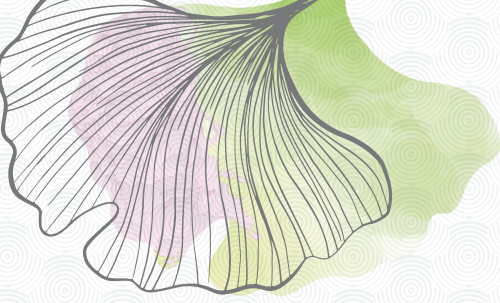

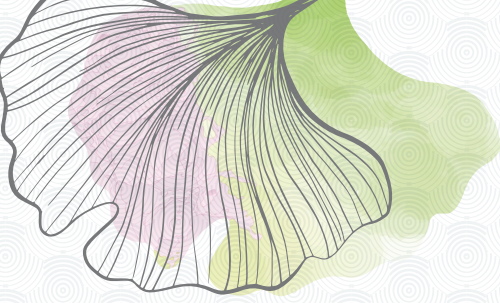
As part of International Infection Prevention Week , Travancore Medicity HIPC team conducted the following activities

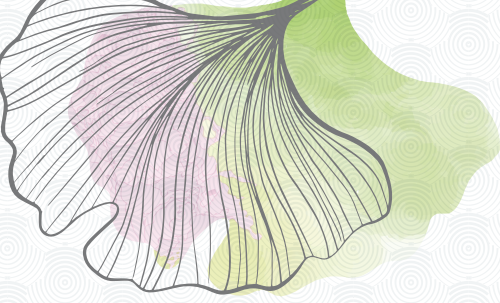
- Poster on infection control week on Travancore Medicity page

- Outreach program to a nearby school – awareness session on Hand hygiene to all students and a Poster competition on Hand hygiene.

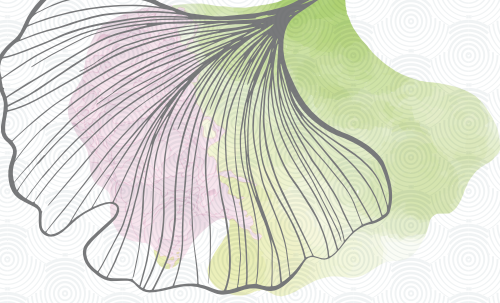


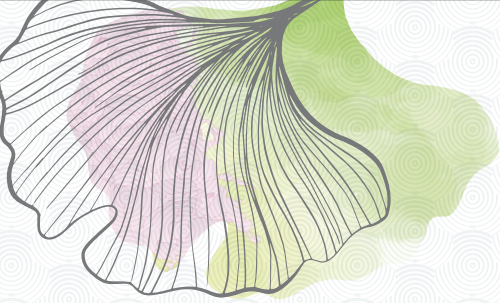






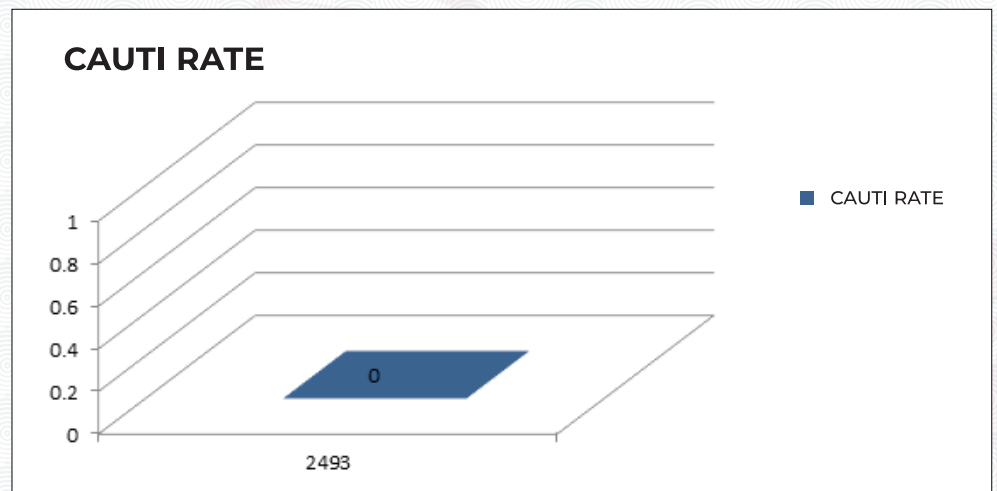




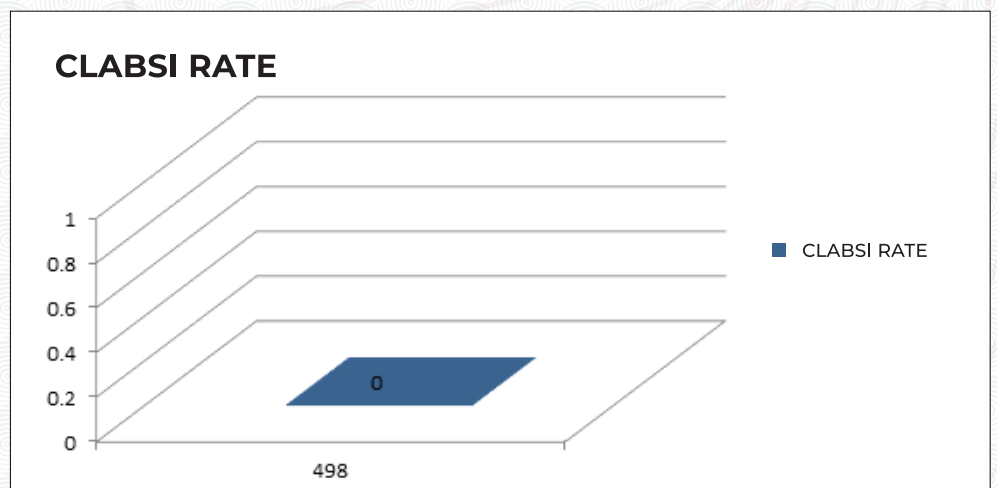


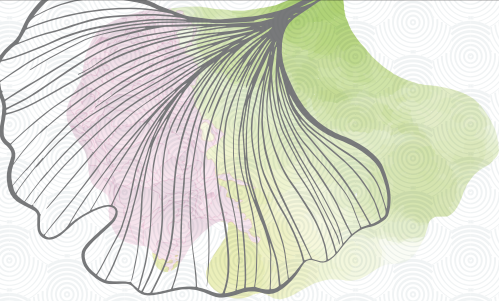

CAUTI RATE - SEPTEMBER 2025

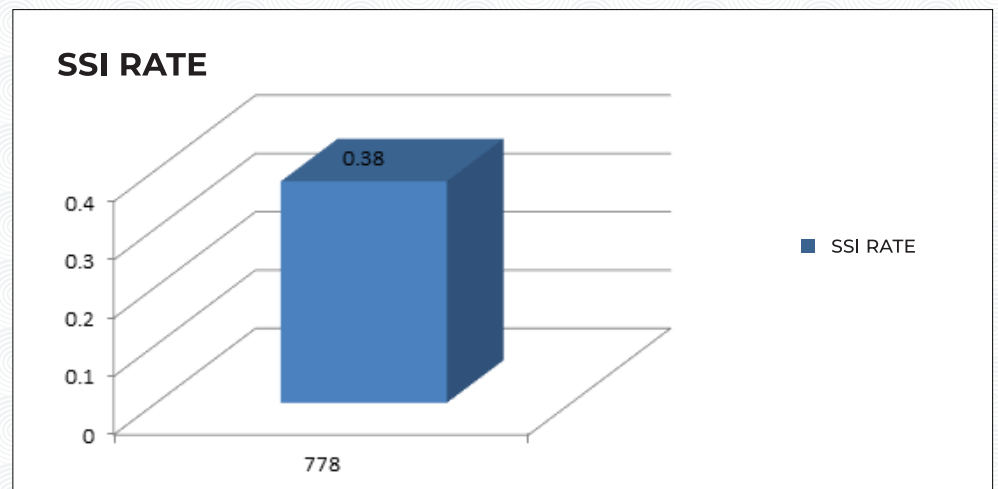


CLABSI RATE - SEPTEMBER 2025

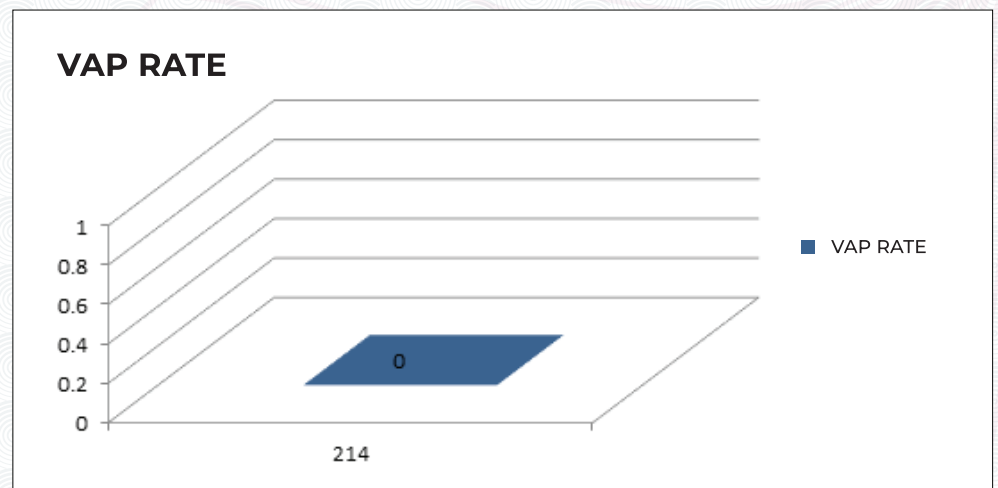




SSI RATE - SEPTEMBER 2025
